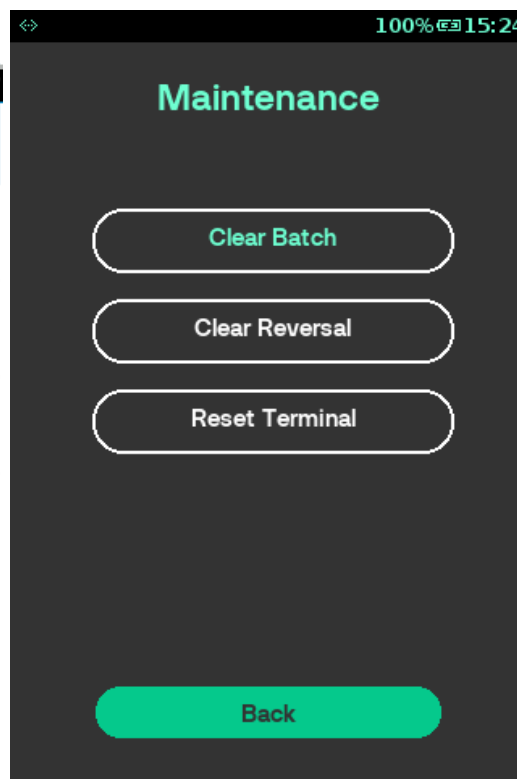

## Clear Batch


The Clear Batch allows the User to clear transactions in the batch manually without settlement.

This menu item is used to clear reversal transactions from the batch.

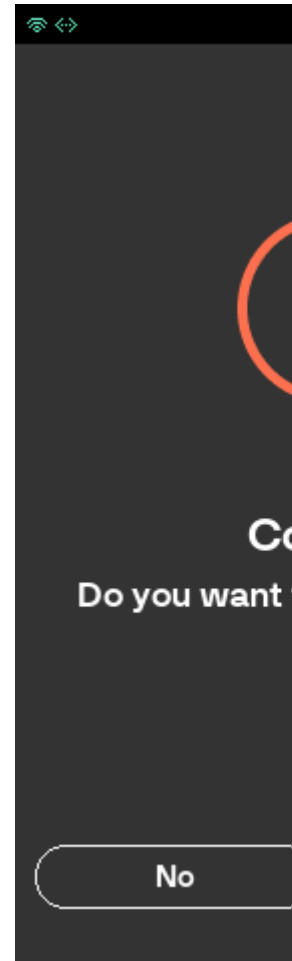

- If no reversal data exists, terminal proceeds step 3.

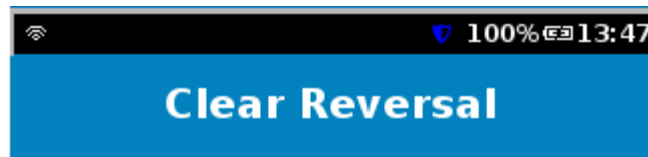

During terminal reset all totals and terminal info will be erased.

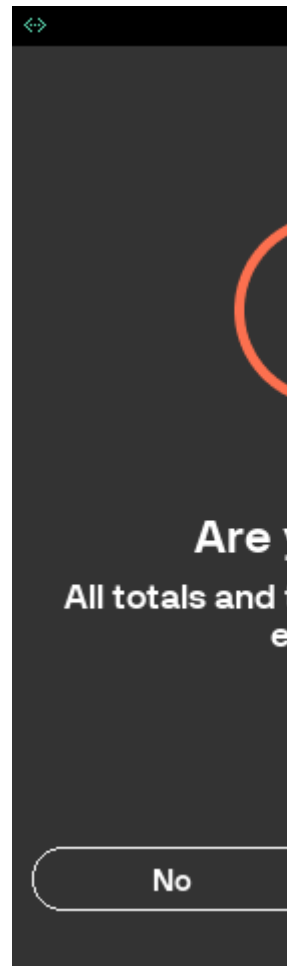
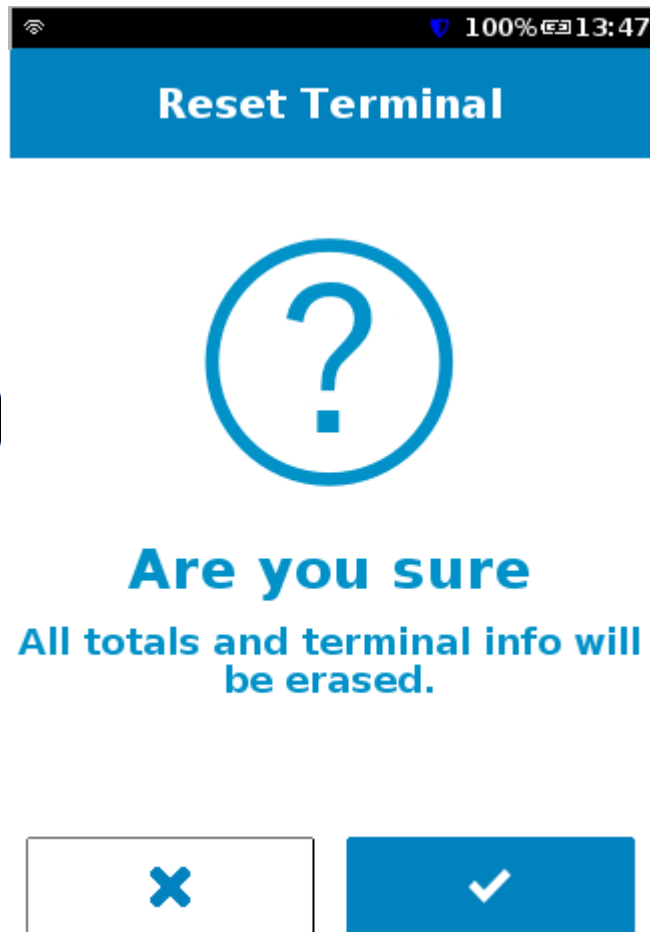
