Worldpay

The Worldpay processor is used for processing transactions with Worldpay Acquiring. It has to be configured with a `merchant_id` in order to identify the merchant to Worldpay when processing transactions.

We also need

- `country_code`
- `address`
- `city`
- `po_box` Note: same as postal code
- `postal_code` Note: e.g NW5 1DJ
- `url` Note: merchant's website url
- `language` Note: e.g en

for settlement purposes.

Customer

The `billing.postal_code` field for UK customers is not allowed to have more than 5 digits.

Currency

The Worldpay connection can only be used with [accounts](#) that have GBP & EUR as their currency.
