

Worldpay

The Worldpay processor is used for processing transactions with Worldpay Acquiring. It has to be configured with a <code>merchant_id</code> in order to identify the merchant to Worldpay when processing transactions.

We also need

- country_code
- address
- [city]
- po_box Note: same as postal code
- postal_code Note: e.g NW5 1DJ
- url Note: merchant's website url
- language Note: e.g en

for settlement purposes.

A processor can be configured through the API:

Customer

The billing.postal_code field for UK customers is not allowed to have more than 5 digits.

Currency

The Worldpay connection can only be used with <u>accounts</u> that have GBP & EUR as their currency.
