### **Fixed Issues**

Fixed Issues in VAOS 6.9.2.1:

- Multi-lane
  - Removed base control manager apk from devices that do not support Full feature base for example, P630 Plus-A, M425-A,
    M450-A, etc
  - o Android 13 Sysmode now supports copying VRK certificates on external storage (USB and SD cards)
  - Fixed access issue when using the serial connector on Orange dongles on an M425-A or M450-A

Fixed Issues in VAOS 6.9.2:

- All NEO and NEO2-based devices
  - Add support for password-protected applications including settings
- Portable and Mobile
  - o A13: All Verifone-based apps are now included in POST\_NOTIFICATIONS's protection level to auto-grant this permission
  - Settings: Android 13 now supports password-protected applications and settings as on Android 10
- Countertop
  - o Fixed issue with double tap gestures on camera, which can start the camera during sleep mode.

Fixed Issues in VAOS 6.9.1:

- All NEO and NEO2-based devices
  - o Android SDK: Fixed an issue with NDK dependencies. It is recommended to update to this version of the Android SDK.
- Portable and Mobile
  - o Android13: Fixed an issue with not freed resources, which caused application crashes after multiple transactions.
  - $\circ\,$  Android 13 settings: APNs are no longer hidden in settings screens.
