


To view/edit basic/advanced parameters for a single device


Follow the option sequence below to view and edit the basic parameters on the Device Details landing page.

Verifone Central -> Device Management -> Devices -> Device Details -> Details -> Parameters




Parameter Management feature supports two levels in basic and five levels in advanced parameter configuration.


