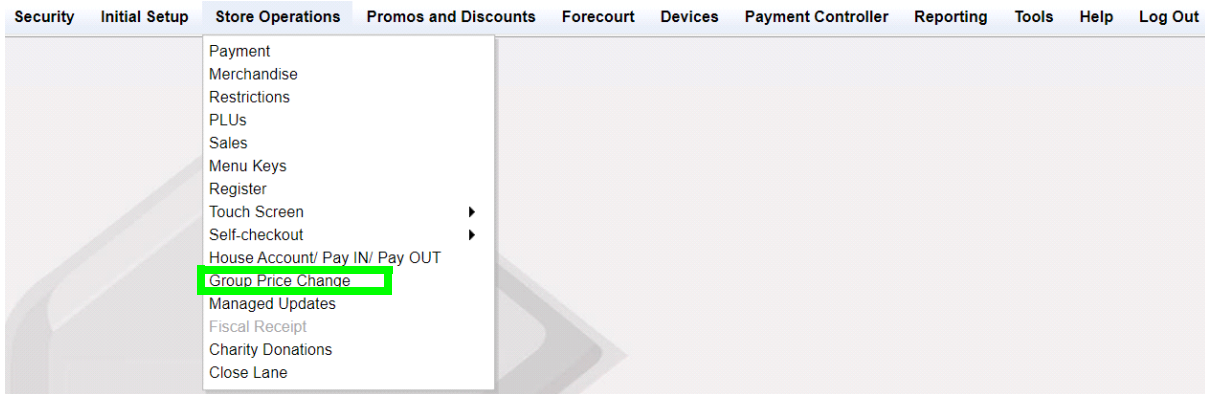
1 OVERVIEW

Feature Description

The Group Price Change feature allows users to change the price of all Price Look Up (PLU) codes within a department individually or by group. All prices within a department can be increased, decreased or made the same and can be adjusted by amount or percentage.

2 CONFIGURING GROUP PRICE CHANGE

From the Commander Configuration Client, go to: **Store Operations > Group Price Change**.



PLU Price Change within a Department

The Group Price Change feature allows a user to change the price of an individual PLU within a department.

1. Select the <Department> containing the PLU to be adjusted.
2. Select the individual <PLU>.

Mark All Prices the Same	Changes all selected PLUs (individual or by group) to the adjustment amount entered.

4. Configure the Adjustment parameter:

Adjustment Option	
Amount	Sets the amount the PLU is increased, decreased or adjusted.
Percent	Sets the percentage amount the PLUs are increased, decreased or adjusted.

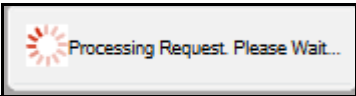
5. Enter the adjustment <amount>.

6. Select [Save] to accept, or [Cancel] to exit without saving changes.

7. When the process has completed, confirm the PLU price adjustment.

In this example, a PLU price increase amount of \$1.00 was applied to the Hot Sausage PLU in the Deli Department.

Group Price Change within a Department

The Group Price Change feature allows a user to change the price of a group of PLUs within a department.

1. Select the <Department> containing the PLUs that need price changes.
2. Click the <PLUs> to be adjusted.

Amount	Sets the amount the PLU is increased, decreased or adjusted.
Percent	Sets the percentage amount the PLUs are increased, decreased or adjusted.

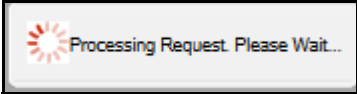
5. Enter the adjustment <amount>.

6. Select [Save] to accept, or [Cancel] to exit without saving changes.

7. When the process has completed, confirm the PLU price adjustments.

In this example, a range of PLU prices for the Deli Department was increased by the adjustment amount of \$0.11.
